A WARM SUMMER GREETINGS TO ALL OF YOU

Dear friends, we are moving through the hottest season of the year. This year we have to be very careful to go through the months of April and May. Secretaries and Coaches of the Associations are reminded to take sufficient care to maintain the health of the shooters. Please provide free drinking water facility to the shooters to maintain their vigor and stamina. In most of the shooting ranges we are conducting now coaching camps, yoga training and treasure hunt programs.

All the Secretaries are informed that as per NRAI guidelines State Rifle Associations have to complete our State Championship 2026 by 31st July. For this purpose we have to conduct our District Championships from 15th May to 31st June. This change is in accordance with the NRAI guidelines. The DRAs can tentatively plan to conduct the District Shooting Championship from 15th May onwards. Plan the date in advance and inform the shooters and KSRA. The presence of an Observer from KSRA will be strictly followed. So please inform me the dates of your District level competitions. All the Secretaries of the DRAs are strictly reminded that the District level competitions must be over within 2 days.

The 58th Kerala State Shooting Championship will be held in the Month of July. The exact date and venue will be informed later. More details regarding the conduct of 58th KSSC will be informed later.

The Pre-National events are expected to begin from September 2026. Shooters are advised to check the details of the competitions in the NRAI Website www.thenrai.in. Shooters are reminded that ISSF has changed the completion rules from 2026 onwards. I am attaching the new ISSF Rule Book and New Pistol Grip Rule 2026 for your reference.
